



## Conflict Minerals Statement

RE: 2010 Dodd Frank Act – Section 1502

CDI Electronics LLC (CDI) supports transparency and consumer awareness regarding the use of conflict minerals and seeks to cut direct and indirect funding of armed groups engaged in the conflict and human rights abuses in the conflict region around the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC). CDI realizes the importance of this initiative and fully supports its spirit.

CDI does not directly source or purchase any conflict minerals from mines or smelters. CDI buys through a vast distribution network, and does not knowingly purchase any component which contains conflict minerals from the conflict region.

To the extent that CDI products may include various components that contain conflict minerals that are necessary to functionality or production of our product:

- We ask our network of suppliers to make every possible effort to source materials only from mines and smelters either outside of the conflict region or ones which have been certified by an independent third party like the Electronics Industry Citizenship Coalition (EICC) as conflict free.
- We support transparency regarding the origin and traceability of minerals contained in components.

We strongly encourage our suppliers to join CDI in our effort to support the conflict minerals issues and respect human rights.
